Adopt a shelter animal today*

Thinking about adopting a pet? Hundreds of homeless companion animals are waiting for a special home just like yours at the **Escondido Humane Society!**

What do I need to do to adopt?

To find an animal that suits you and your family, we suggest either coming to the Escondido Humane Society or visiting us online at www.escondidohumanesociety.org. Once you have found your special friend, an adoptions counselor will ask you to fill out a pre-adoption questionnaire (you also can download one on our Web site). When you have been approved for adoption, an adoption counselor will take the animal out for a personal interaction with the animal that you're interested in. If you have decided on adopting the animal, you can either put a hold on the animal for 24 hours, or you can take your friend home that day!

How much does it cost to adopt an animal?

- Puppies and kittens up to 6 months: \$160
- Adult dogs and cats 6 months to 7 years: \$110
- Senior dogs and cats 7 years and older: \$55
- All ages of rabbits: \$45

Do you have animals available for adoption away from the shelter?

Yes! We offer off-site cat and rabbit adoptions at Petco stores in Escondido, San Marcos, Poway and Carmel Mountain and the PetSmart store in Escondido, and dog adoptions at Dogtopia of San Marcos.

When are you open?

The Escondido Humane Society Adoption Center is open from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. seven days a week. Due to the adoption process, we ask that you be at the shelter by 4 p.m. We stop interactions and adoptions at 4:30 p.m.
