**Monday:**

**10 AM-11AM:**

Every morn we start with our Animal Jokes of the day, Animal trivia facts of the day and can you guess the correct animal answer? (Win a prize)

Behind the scenes tour of the facility including dog, cat room, feed the bunnies in the bunny room, pet and play with the cats in the cat room, feed and pet the farm animals, visit the tortoise habitat

**11A—noon**

Visit the animal nursery and see the newborn babies

Meet and pet 3 of the Education animals, (could be hamster, guinea pigs, mice, rat, lizards, snakes, etc.)

**Tuesday**

**10Am-11AM**

Usual introduction

Learn how to use an old fashioned spinning wheel to spin the wool from the sheep into yarn.

Meet a real animal cop/forest ranger and learn what they really do and meet their animals

**11 AM-noon**

Wild Animal Show-some of the animals shown were: monkeys, sloth, exotic birds, frogs, snakes, pigs, miniature horses, etc.

**Wednesday**

**10 Am – 11 AM**

Llama and alpaca rides around the shelter

**11AM-noon**

Pet First Aid-children learn what to do in an emergency with their pets. Using stuffed animals as their “patients”, this will give them good advice and experience should they need it. Video included

**Thursday**

**10 AM-11AM**

Usual opening

The Sheriff Department brings their search and rescue dogs and shows the children what the dogs do  
Bake dog biscuits to take home for their pets

**11AM-noon**

Reptile Lady brings reptiles of all sorts for the children to meet and pet

**Friday**

**10 AM-11AM**

Usual opening

House Rabbit Society brings bunnies for the children to pet

Meet vet-Children get to talk and ask questions of a vet

**11AM-noon**

4H club brings goats for the children to milk
